REGISTER FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM TRAINING IN BOSCOBEL AUGUST 28TH

In the last few years, flooding, tornadoes, landslides, and hail have hit southwest Wisconsin many times. Only certified Emergency Response Team members are allowed to help start the first phase of the cleanup process. Those interested in becoming certified are invited to attend Emergency Response Team Training at Boscobel UMC, 104 Buchanan St in Boscobel on Friday, August 28th from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturday, August 29th from 8 a.m. until noon. The cost for the class is \$20. Registration is due Wednesday, August 26th. Certified ERT members must be 18 or older, and pass a background check. This class is the ticket to working with a team of committed people who will seek to bring order to those whose lives have been touched by a disaster.
