During the school year, the kids in grades K-5th are invited to Children's Church. Children are usually dismissed to the fellowship hall for CC during the hymn. We also have green activity bags with crayons, coloring books, etc. hanging in the lobby. Feel free get one for your child to use at any time during Worship.

**Questions** If you have questions or need assistance please stop at Java Jct or ask any of our usher/greeters.

**Refreshments** Please enjoy coffee and other refreshments with us at Java Jct! A water fountain is also located in the lobby.

**Reminders** Please turn cell phones to silent mode prior to the start of Worship.
